COLLEGE TESTING

<u>SAT Test:</u> The fee is \$54.50. You can register online at <u>www.collegeboard.com</u>. Our school code is 470-669. The SAT will be given on the following dates: March 5 (register by 2/5), May 7 (register by 4/8) — June 4 (register by 5/5).

<u>PSAT Prep Classes (grades 10-12)</u>: There will be classes on Wednesday afternoons for the next three weeks-February 10, 17, and 24 from 3:00-5:00 pm. The cost is \$20. To sign up, please stop in the office and see Mrs. Crozier.

<u>Sophomores:</u> This year, there is a new PSAT 10 test, designed for sophomores, who would like to begin the college entrance testing process. Any Sophomore who wants to take the new PSAT 10 at WCA on March 1, 2016 may do so — especially if you are in Algebra 2 this year. The cost of the PSAT 10 is \$15 per student. Please sign up for the test by bringing the \$15 to Mrs. Crozier by Monday, February 15.
