PLEASE HELP US !!!!!

Please help with the health and safety of our students and staff. Although regular school attendance is important, students must not attend school if sick. Some examples are:

- ◆ FEVER — Before a student can return to school, their temperature must be below 100° for at least 24 hours WITHOUT any-fever reducing medicine.
- ◆ VOMITING AND/OR DIARRHEA — A student must be symptom free for at least 12 hours before returning to school.

CLASS DUES — GRADES 7th—12th

If you have a student in the 7th-12th grades, class dues are required. Class dues are escrowed from year to year for the purpose of eventually helping to fund the Jr/Sr Banquet and Senior Class Trip as well as helping with class field trips in each class each school year. The following is a breakdown of class dues for each grade: (7th & 8th Grade — \$30.00), (9th & 10th Grade — \$40.00), (11th & 12th Grade — \$50.00). Checks should be made payable to WCA with the notation "Class Dues" with the grade(s) listed. ***Please do not include the class dues in with your normal tuition payment as class dues are placed into a separate checking account.*** Thank you so much!
