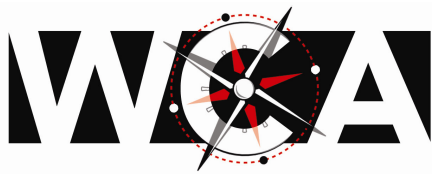
HONOR SOCIETY BOOK DRIVE FOR THE WCA LIBRARY
